Hoosier Sire Program Rules

1. American Haflinger Registry registered Stallions that are 100% owned and standing in Indiana are eligible to be nominated.
2. A first time nominating fee of \$10 to enter a new Stallion in the Hoosier Sire Program is due January 21.
3. Stallion owners pay \$10 per mare bred each year along with a copy of the IHHA breeding report due January 21, of the following year.
4. Any mare regardless of state that is registered with the American Haflinger Registry and bred to a participating Indiana Stallion is eligible.
5. Mare owners regardless of state pay \$10 per mare bred each year due January 21, of the following year, this nominates her foal.
6. A late fee of \$100 is allowed per weanling or yearling purchased or owned that was not originally nominated by mare owner.
7. Foals are to be shown when they become yearlings in the Hoosier Sire Program class at the Indiana State Fair.
8. A copy of the Original Registration Paper (front & back) must be presented at the show, or sent with the show entry form.
9. An entry fee of \$25 to show in the Hoosier Sire Program class at the Indiana State Fair is due July 10, payable to IHHA. Entry form is on IHHA website.
10. All Hoosier Sire Program yearlings are eligible to show in the morning open class at the Indiana State Fair. Send open class entry to: State Fair Entry Department in Indianapolis by July 1, or go online at www.indianastatefair.com
11. When yearling is to be shown only in the Hoosier Sire Program class, the horse must arrive by 9:00 A.M. morning of show and may leave after show. A one day stall fee is required by the state fair payable at the draft horse office upon arrival.
12. Premium checks will be mailed within two weeks after show.
